The conference is an internationally renowned conference that publishes the studies of artificial intelligence in computer games. **CG2018** will be held during **July 9-11**, and **Computer Olympiad** will take place during **July 7-13**.

- General scientific contribution produced by the study of games
- Cognitive research of how humans play games

- Issues related to networked games

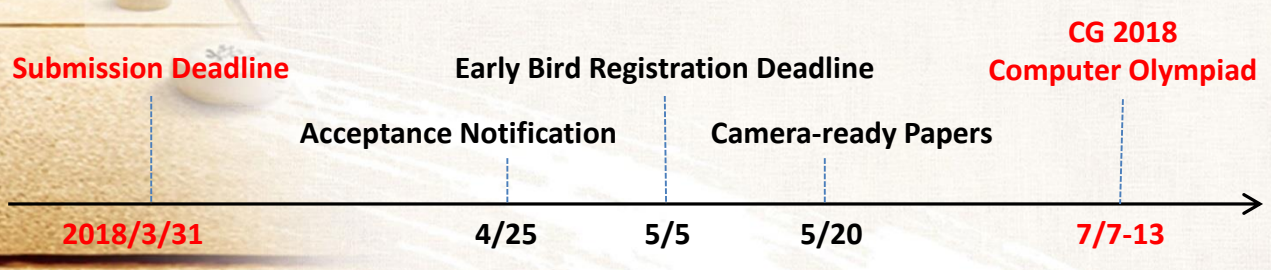
